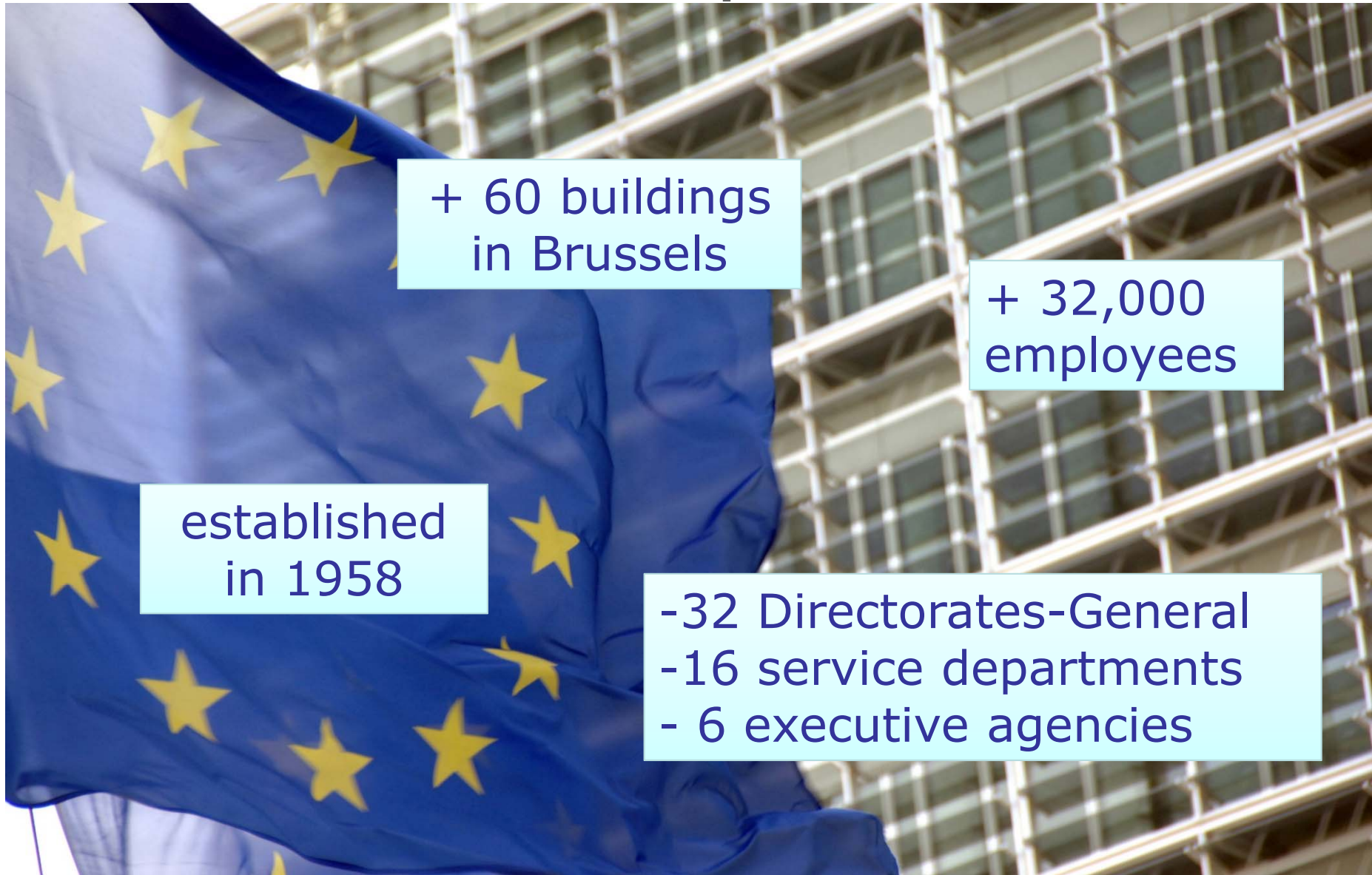

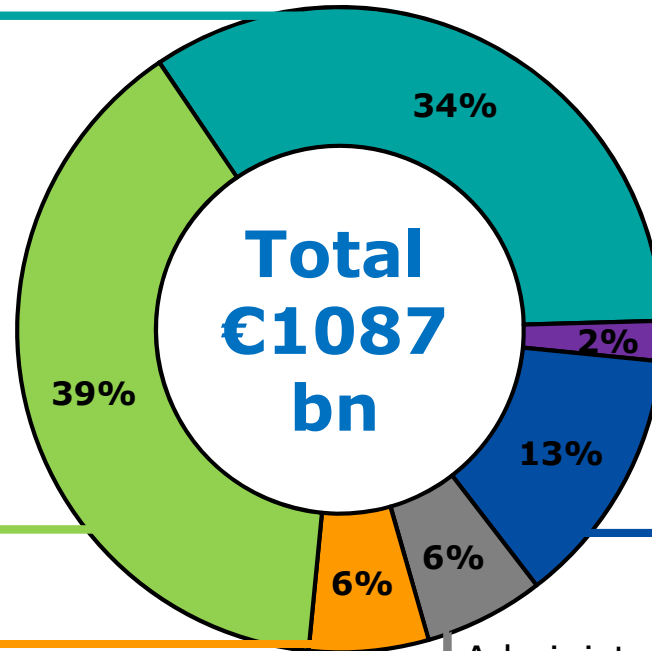
EU budget 2014-2020 - expenditure

Competitiveness for growth and jobs (142.1 bn)

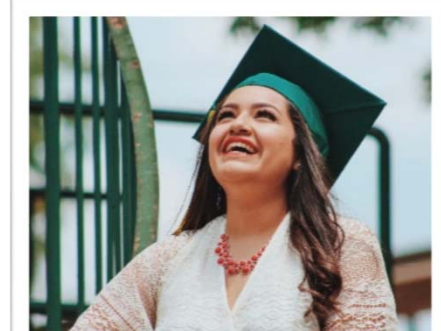


Sustainable Growth: Natural Resources (420 bn)

Global Europe (66.3 bn)

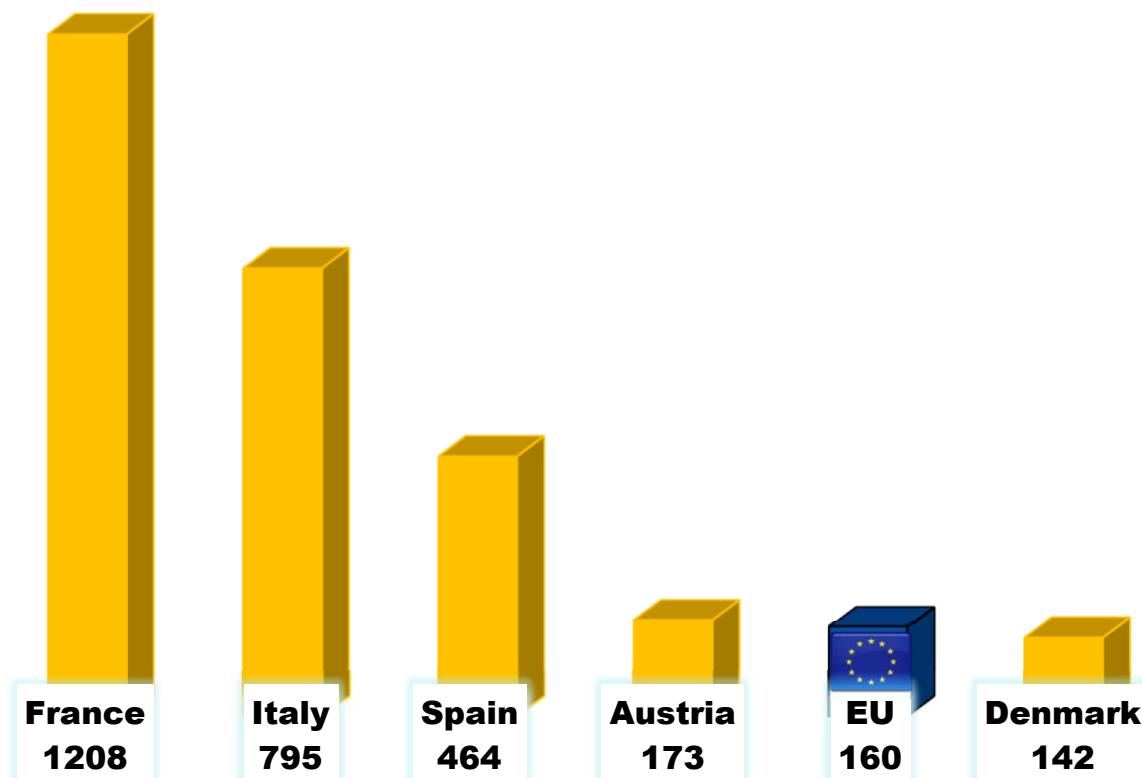


Administration (69.6 bn)

A topic with high priority: COVID-19



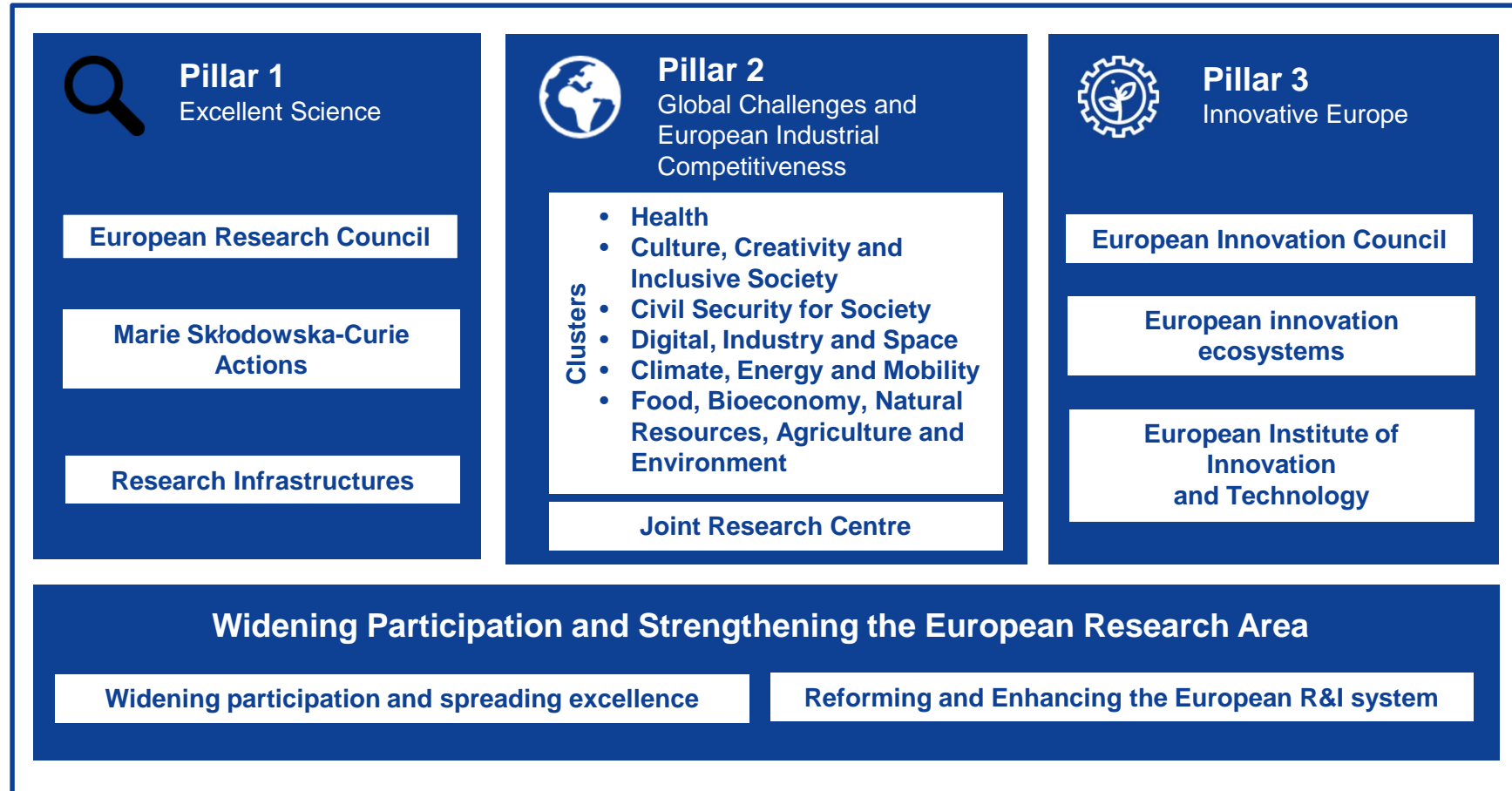
- ❑ EU has mobilised €10 million for research

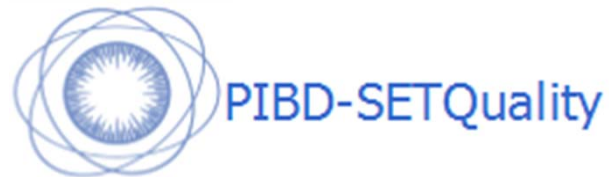

Health Care Systems

A project example funded under Horizon 2020



- The project title is 'Paediatric Inflammatory Bowel Diseases Network for Safety, Efficacy, Treatment and Quality improvement of care'
- La **Sapienza** is receiving over € 190,000
- The coordinator is Université Paris Descartes – in total there are 12 participants
- Work accomplished includes: organization of the randomized controlled clinical trial (RCT) with integrated pharmacological analyses, health economic analyses etc.

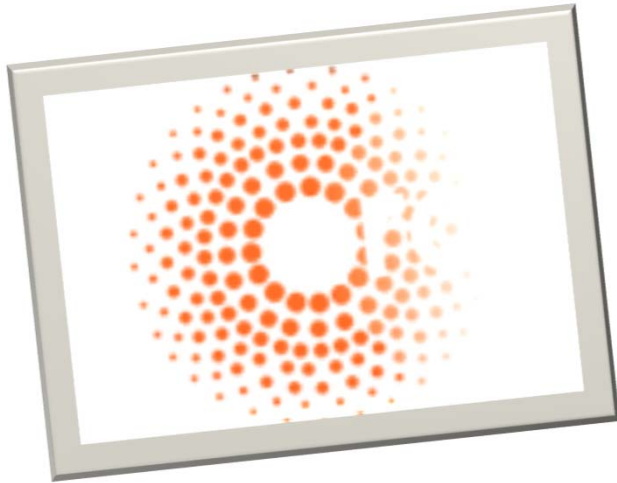

Directorate General Health and Food Safety

- Responsible for EU policy on food safety and health and for monitoring the implementation of related laws
- One of the branches of this DG is related to public health, e.g.
 - ✓ *Pharmaceuticals* - European Medicines Agency (EMA)
 - ✓ *Diseases and health threats* - European Centre for Disease Prevention and Control (ECDC)
- Another branch is food safety and quality, farming and fisheries
 - ✓ *Food safety* – European Food Safety Authority (EFSA)

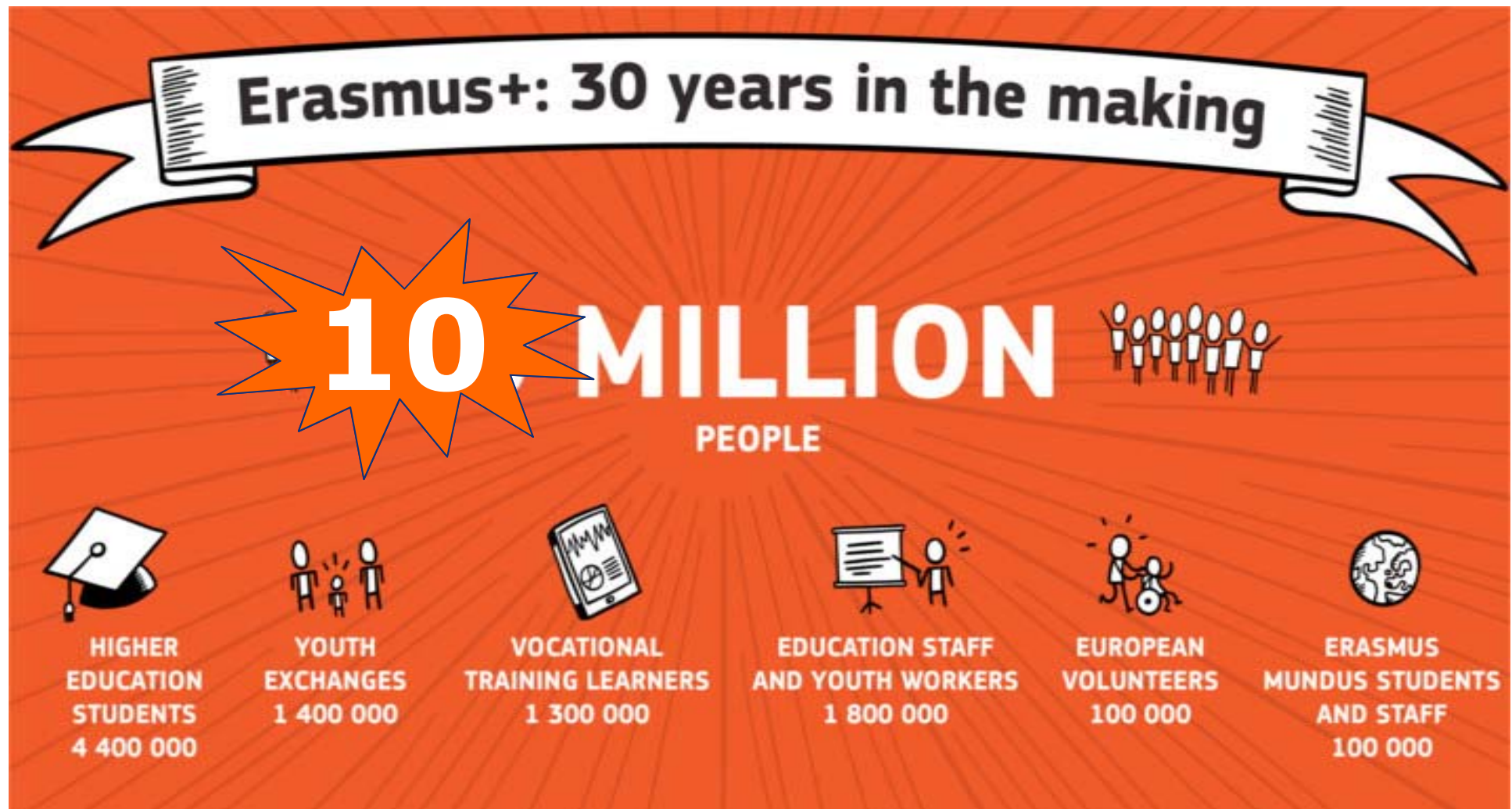

DID YOU KNOW THAT...?

... More and more young people are using Erasmus+ exchanges to gain valuable work experience abroad

... 1 in 3 Erasmus+ trainees are offered a position by the company they trained in

... Five years after graduation, the unemployment rate of young people who studied or trained abroad is 23% lower than that of their non-mobile peers

... Since the start of Erasmus+ (2014), over 2 million people have participated in the programme

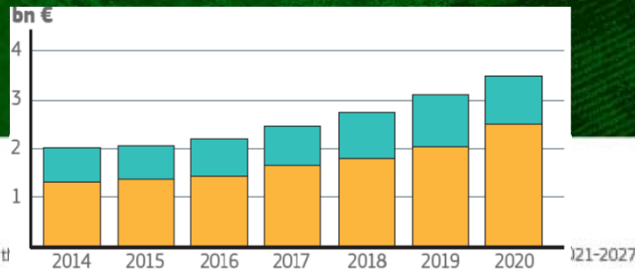
... Erasmus+ is helping to address match-fixing and doping in sports

... 1 in 3 youth mobility participants comes from a disadvantaged background

European Solidarity Corps



- European Solidarity Corps projects will be available to people up to the age of 30 years old
- Individual volunteering lets young people participate in the daily work of organisations and lasts between 2 and 12 months, and in some cases, 2 weeks and up
- Volunteering teams are groups of 10-40 young people from at least two different countries who volunteer together for a period of between 2 weeks and 2 months
- Traineeships count as full-time work practice and last between 2 and 6 months – renewable once. They are paid for by the organisation responsible for the traineeship
- Jobs are full-time and last between 3 and 12 months. They are paid for by the organisation employing the participant

Trainsheep at the EU



- Duration:
 - ✓ March to the end of July
 - ✓ October to the end of February the following year
- Working hours: 40 hours a week, 8 hours per day
- The living allowance for the traineeship sessions in 2020 will be €1,220.78 per month
- Tasks include: attending and organising meetings, drafting and editing documentation, supporting the management of projects, etc.
- Where?

European Commission, European Parliament, Council of the European Union, Court of Justice, Committee of the Regions, European Economic and Social Committee, etc.

Working for an EU institution

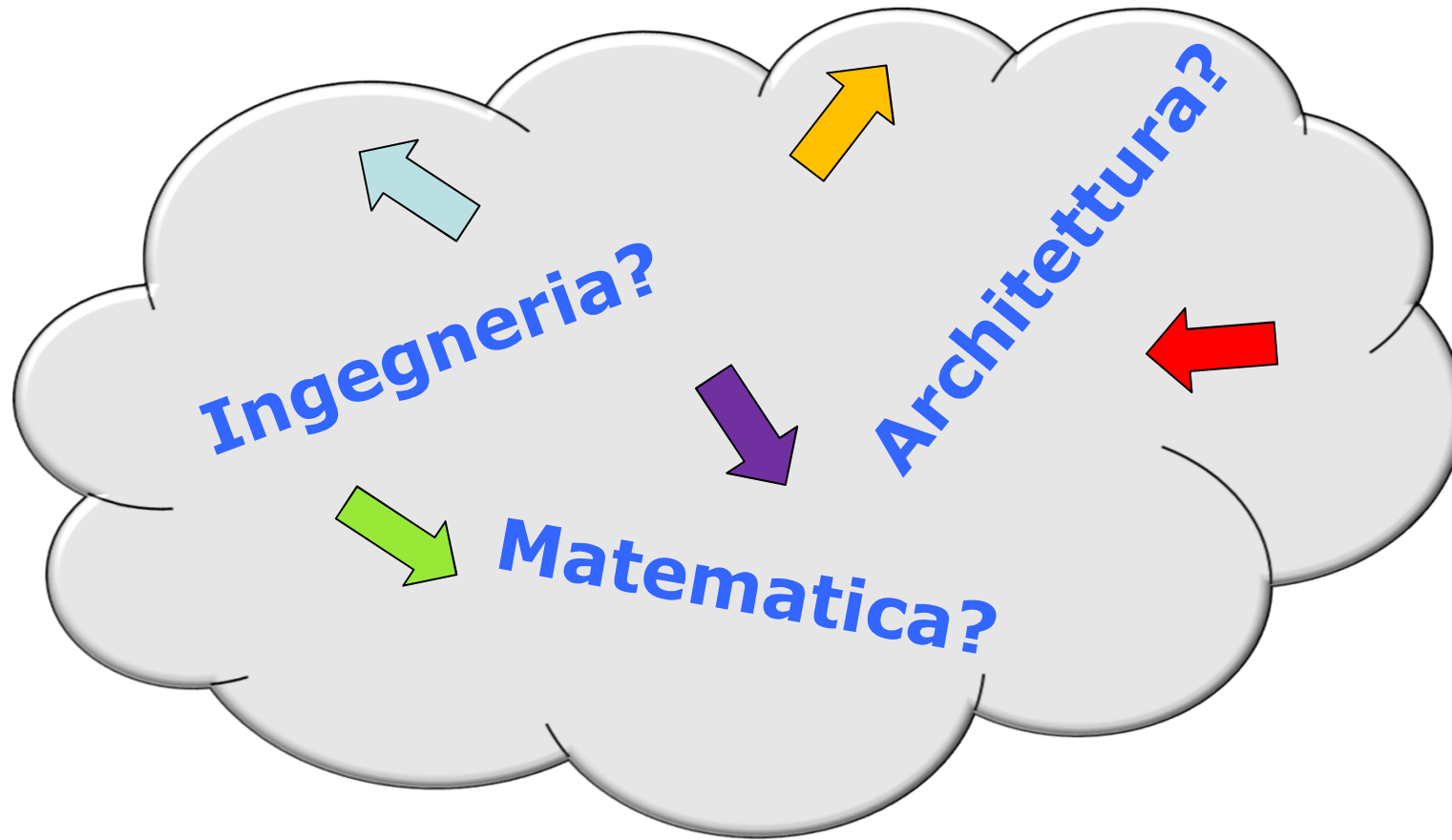


- Applications to European Personnel Selection Office (EPSO)
- Several types of contracts: permanent contract, a fixed-term contract and a temporary contract
- Administrators (AD) and Assistants (AST)
- Permanent contracts are selected through open competitions (published on EPSO); applicants who pass a competition are placed on a reserve list
- Possibilities to work also: as temporary agency worker, Seconded National Expert, translator, Assistant to a Member of the European Parliament...

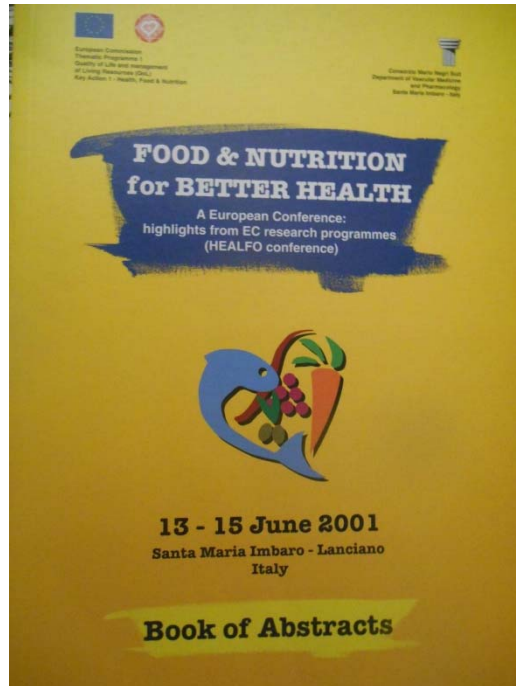

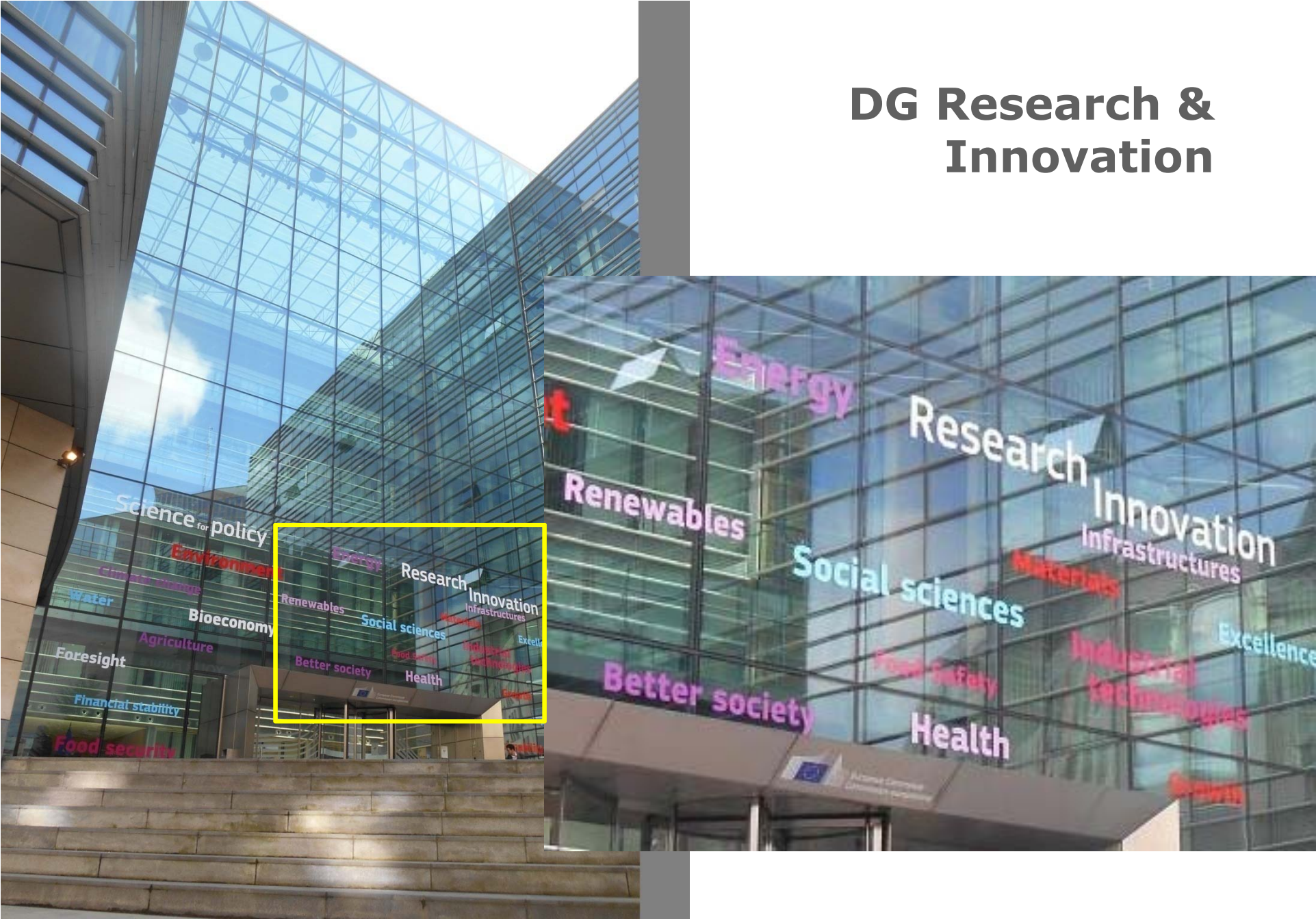
