# International academic mobility: the new calls

A 2025 full of initiatives for the internationalization of didactic and research has begun. Through the Newsletter, the Internationalization Commission intends to inform the students of our Faculty in a concise but effective way.

An intense period began on 19 December 2024 which will see the publication of international mobility calls for the **2025-2026 academic year**, including:

- the **University calls** which include the Erasmus+ call for study and thesis in Europe, the Erasmus+ call for Traineeship in Europe, the ICM extra-European mobility call;
- the **calls managed directly by the Faculty** which include the call for the Overseas extra-European mobility program and the call for thesis abroad.

The Faculty intends to facilitate **the international mobility** of our students also through "free mover" mobility which expands the opportunities offered by the University by providing for the recognition of experiences independently proposed by our students, in compliance with the deadlines and authorizations provided for by the new regulation approved in October 2024.





# The Sapienza Erasmus+ calls for Study and Traineeship

Setting off for an international study mobility experience in a European university or for a period of professional training in a research center, hospital, pharmaceutical industry is certainly a challenge that requires commitment, but it will change your life!

#### **DEADLINES:**

- ➤ The call <u>Erasmus+ for study</u> was published on 19 December 2024 and the first deadline was **20 February**. The unassigned destinations will be made available from 16 April (approx) and the second deadline will be **20 May**.
- ➤ The call <u>Erasmus+ Traineeship</u> published on 19 February, will remain open until **14 April**.

## The mobility Free mover

A "free mover" is defined as a student who chooses the host university on his own initiative, organizing the study period abroad independently.

Without prejudice to the definition of "free mover" student given by Sapienza University of Rome and the general methods for carrying out this type of mobility, the Faculty of Pharmacy and Medicine, together with the other Faculties of Health Sciences in Sapienza, has updated the "free mover" regulation to adapt it to changing times and needs of students. At this link you can download the regulation (found at the bottom of the page).

In short, "free mover" mobility does not include any financial contribution from Sapienza and requires evaluation by the RAM and authorization of your Course of Study. Once the training project for study and/or internship abroad has been approved (min. 1 month, max. 6 months), mobility will be recognized upon return to Sapienza.



## The OVERSEAS call of the Faculty of Pharmacy and Medicine

Like every year, the medical area of the Faculty proposes an international mobility offer that arises from **bilateral agreements** with prestigious academies in the world and which were signed following meetings promoted at both University and Faculty level.

Thanks to funds provided by the MUR, our students will have the opportunity to benefit from a scholarship to spend **a minimum period of 13 weeks** (90 days) abroad to take exams, carry out curricular internships or research for thesis. Each mobility carried out within the OVERSEAS program provides exemption from the payment of registration fees at the host University and recognition of the activities carried out abroad.

The call will be published by end of February and the deadline will be March 31.
