International academic mobility: the new University and Faculty calls

We are about to enter a 2026 packed with initiatives for the internationalization of teaching. Through this newsletter, the Internationalization Committee intends to inform Faculty students in a concise, yet hopefully effective and useful, manner.

An intense period began on December 16, 2025, marked by the publication of calls for international mobility for the 2026–2027 academic year, including:

- **University-level calls for applications**, such as the Erasmus+ call for Study in Europe (published on December 16, 2025), the Erasmus+ call for Traineeships in Europe, and the ICM call for non-European mobility (to be published soon);
- **Faculty-level calls for applications**, including the Overseas Programme for non-European mobility (published on December 29, 2025) and the call for theses abroad.

On the following page, you will find details and useful links to help you navigate the calls for applications currently available, as well as other active initiatives, such as the “free mover” international mobility programme. This initiative expands the opportunities offered by the University by granting recognition for mobility experiences independently proposed by students, provided they are approved in advance by their respective degree programmes.



The Sapienza Erasmus+ calls for Study and thesis abroad

Setting off for an international study mobility experience in a European university is certainly a challenge that requires commitment, but it will change your life!

The Erasmus+ Programme for Study Mobility is a European Union programme that supports the completion of a period of study abroad, during which it is possible to: attend university courses and pass the related exams; combine a period of study with a period of curricular internship (only if provided by the academic regulations); carry out research for the preparation of a degree thesis.

DEADLINES:

The [Erasmus+ call for study](#) was published on 16 December 2025: the first deadline is scheduled for 12 February 2026 (1:00 p.m.). Any remaining destinations will be made available, and the second deadline will be 27 May 2026.

The mobility Free mover

A student is defined as a “free mover” when they independently choose the host university and autonomously organize their period of study abroad.

Without prejudice to [the definition of “free mover” student](#) provided by Sapienza University of Rome and the **general procedures for carrying out this type of mobility**, in October 2024 the Faculty of Pharmacy and Medicine, together with the other Faculties of Health Sciences at Sapienza, updated the “free mover” regulations to adapt them to changing times and students’ needs. [At this link](#), it is possible to download the regulations (they are located at the bottom of the page, among the attachments).

In short, “free mover” mobility **does not provide any financial contribution** from Sapienza and requires evaluation by the RAM and **authorization** from the student’s Degree Programme. Once the study and/or traineeship project abroad has been approved (min. 1 month, max. 6 months), the mobility period will be recognized upon the student’s return to Sapienza

Like every year, the **medical area** of the Faculty proposes an international mobility offer that arises from **bilateral agreements** with prestigious academies in the world and which were signed following meetings promoted at both University and Faculty level.

Thanks to funds provided by the MUR, our students will have the opportunity to benefit from a scholarship to spend a **minimum period of 13 weeks** (90 days) abroad to take exams, carry out curricular internships or research for thesis. Each mobility carried out within the [OVERSEAS program](#) provides exemption from the payment of registration fees at the host University and recognition of the activities carried out abroad.
